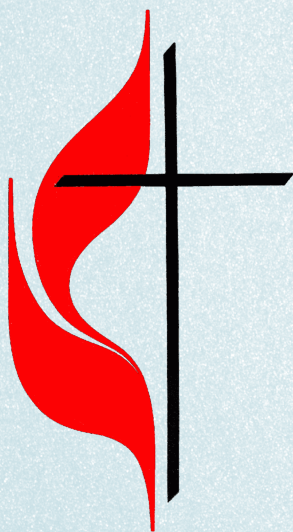
CULPEPER WARMING SHELTER
